America's Amateur Model & Talent Competition is for girls young women and is dedicated to the advancement of modeling and talent through competitive events, the establishment of professional ethics and the standardization of training. The competition is open to all amateur models and/or those engaged in the performing arts, regardless of their affiliation with any other modeling or talent association or pageant.

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NOTE: There are limited entries available. Entry is first come, first served. To ensure participation, you must register ASAP. Entries will accepted during event registration on a limited basis only (if at all)!

WHO MAY COMPETE IN AAMTC
Any amateur may enter AAMTC (anyone who has not made more than \$6,000 in a calendar year through either a modeling or talent contract).

SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

Events have been scheduled so that contestants may participate in every category, especially those who are trying for the overall awards.

MODELING AND TALENT AGE DIVISIONS

Modeling and Talent events will be broken into the following age divisions: 3-6, 7-9, 10-12, 13-17, 18+ & Over -married or single. Age Divisions might be combined so that a minimum of 12 entrants per division is achieved.

CATEGORY AWARDS

Official AAMTC awards will be given to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in each modeling and talent category. In the event that there are less than three (3) participants in a category, the judges (at their discretion) may withhold giving a 1st place award if they feel the participant is not qualified for such an award.

OVERALL "AAMTC MODEL OF THE YEAR" AWARDS

To qualify for the overall modeling awards, a participant must have entered the Partywear category and any other four modeling categories of their choice (minimum: 5 modeling categories). Points from the required category and the four highest points from other categories entered (you may enter as many categories as you desire) will be tabulated in the following manner: Each 1st place - 3 pts; each 2nd place - 2 pts; each 3rd place - 1 pt. The participant accumulating the highest number of points in each age division will be awarded the official "AAMTC MODEL OF THE YEAR" international title, banner, trophy, crown and a \$250.00 CASH AWARD. (A "model-off" in the garment of your choice will be held in the event of a tie). your choice will be held in the event of a tie).

OVERALL "AAMTC TALENT OF THE YEAR" AWARDS

To qualify for the overall talent awards, a participant must enter a minimum of three (3) solo talent categories. The highest points from 3 talent categories entered (you may enter as many categories as you desire) will be tabulated as follows: Each 1st place - 3 pts; each 2nd place - 2 pts; each 3rd place - 1 pt. The participant with the highest number of points in each age division will be awarded the official "AAMTC TALENT OF THE YEAR" fittle, banner, trophy, crown and a \$250.00 CASH AWARD. (In the event of a tie, those making the tie will perform again in order to break the tie).

METHOD OF ADJUDICATION

AAMTC modeling and talent competitions are NOT BEAUTY CONTESTS; however, good grooming and overall appearance will be taken into consideration. Modeling will be judged on: 1) Posture & Body Alignment; 2) Walk & Movements; 3) Interpretation of Garment; 4) Presentation; 5) Composition of Routine. Talent will be judged on: 1) Appearance; 2) Composition of Routine; 3) Variety & Difficulty; 4) Execution; 5) Presentation.

RULES & REGULATIONS

Models choose their own garments. Props are not appropriate for this type of high fashion runway modeling. All garment categories will be "runway modeling" and the participant will be expected to show proper entrance and exit, a basic pivot or other turn and the necessary detailing and interpretation of the garment. Smoothness, flow (fluid motion), showmanship and sales ability are all important attributes for a good model. A minimum of 12 participants must be entered in an age division in Modeling and in Talent. If less than 12 participants are entered in an age division, divisions may be combined with the next older or younger age division.

MODELING PROCEDURE

AAMTC is "free style" and there is no set modeling pattern. However, participants should consider this as high fashion runway modeling, much like that exhibited at New York Fashion Week or that can be observed on popular TV shows like Project Runway. Upbeat, generic, instrumental music will be used. Models are instructed to keep pace with the tempo of the music while highlighting the particular garment they are wearing. A modeling demonstration will be provided at orientation.

DESCRIPTION OF MODELING CATEGORIES PARTYWEAR / COCKTAIL (Required Modeling Category) The correct dress for this division will be short or tea-length dress that would appropriate for the participant if the upper attention

be appropriate for the participant if she were attending a party or social event.

INTERVIEW

Outfit should be one which would be worn at a casual social function such as church, a personal interview, etc. Suggested styles of clothing would be a casual dress, skirt and blouse, slacks with jacket, etc.

SWIMWEAR

Any type of swimsuit selected by the participant. Swimsuit selection should be in good taste and appropriate for the age division of the participant. In this category a swimsuit "cover-up" may be worn and removed during modeling but is not required.

CASUALWEAR

The participant should select a garment that reflects a casual or very informal mood. Suggested styles are sundress, pant suits, skirts with blouse. An outfit that one might wear while shopping or attending a casual brunch.

FORMALWEAR
Long or tea-length gown which would be worn to a formal evening occasion such as a wedding, formal party, ball, etc.

SLEEPWEAR/LOUNGEWEAR

Pajamas, nightshirt or night gown is appropriate attire for this modeling category. NOTE: In this category the participant may wear and remove a robe during the modeling presentation; however, it is not required.

WESTERN WEAR

The appropriate wardrobe could be as practical as blue jeans and boots or as whimsical as a "rhinestone cowboy" look. The judges will be looking for any outfit, serious or fun, that evokes a "western wear" look.

PHOTOGENIC

Judged on photogenic qualities of participant. Turn in photo at registration. (DO NOT MAIL). Photo may be black & white or color. Photos will be returned. Judged on photographic beauty, mood or expression and quality of photograph.

SOLO TALENT COMPETITION

Entrants may enter as many talent categories as desired; however they may NOT enter more than one talent act within a category. Presentations should be about 2-minutes in length but may NOT EXCEED 2:30 minutes. Hand props, but NO SCENERY, are allowed. A microphone will be provided. Any other equipment is the participant's own responsibility. No type of fire or knife act or special lighting effects will be allowed. A minimum of 12 participants must be entered in a division or the division may be cancelled.

TALENT MUSIC

At Registration, participants must furnish their music on a THUMB DRIVE in .mp3 file format. There can be only **1 song per thumb drive**, therefore you must supply a separate thumb drive for EACH talent that requires recorded music. No Compact Discs Allowed! Remember, the Talent presentation CANNOT exceed 2:30 minutes.
